

Foreign-born workers are more likely to be paid low wages...

The bars show the prevalence of low-wage work among foreign-born and US-born workers. For example, 38.5% of all foreign-born workers are paid low wages.



In 2022, the value of the low-wage threshold is \$19.69. The sample includes workers who live and work in California, were employed last week but not self-employed, ages 16+, and with non-zero earnings last week.
