
## The majority of workers paid less than \$19.69 work full time and year-round

The bars show the share of workers paid low wages (compared to all workers) who usually work full time (35 hours per week or more) or part time, and full year (50 weeks) or part year.



In 2022, the value of the low-wage threshold is \$19.69. The sample includes workers who live in California, were employed last week but not self-employed, ages 16+, and with non-zero earnings last week.
