
Workers paid low wages are more likely to rent and be rentburdened

The bars show the share of workers paid low wages (compared to all workers) who rent and who are rent-burdened (paying more than 30% of household income on rent).



In 2022, the value of the low-wage threshold is \$19.69. The sample includes workers who live in California, were employed last week but not self-employed, ages 16+, with non-zero earnings last week, and who pay rent.
