

# Workers paid low wages are more likely to rent and be rent-burdened

The bars show the share of workers paid low wages (compared to all workers) who rent and who are rent-burdened (paying more than 30% of household income on rent).



*In 2022, the value of the low-wage threshold is \$19.69. The sample includes workers who live in California, were employed last week but not self-employed, ages 16+, with non-zero earnings last week, and who pay rent.*
