
More than 1 out of 3 Pacific Islander and Southeast Asian women are paid low wages

The bars show the prevalence of low-wage work among Asian American and Pacific Islander (AAPI) workers by gender. For example, about 26.6% of Pacific Islander men and 37.0% of Pacific Islander women are paid a low wage.



In 2022, the value of the low-wage threshold is \$19.69. The sample includes workers who live and work in California, were employed last week but not self-employed, ages 16+, and with non-zero earnings last week. See "Data and Methods" for the definition of each AAPI group.
