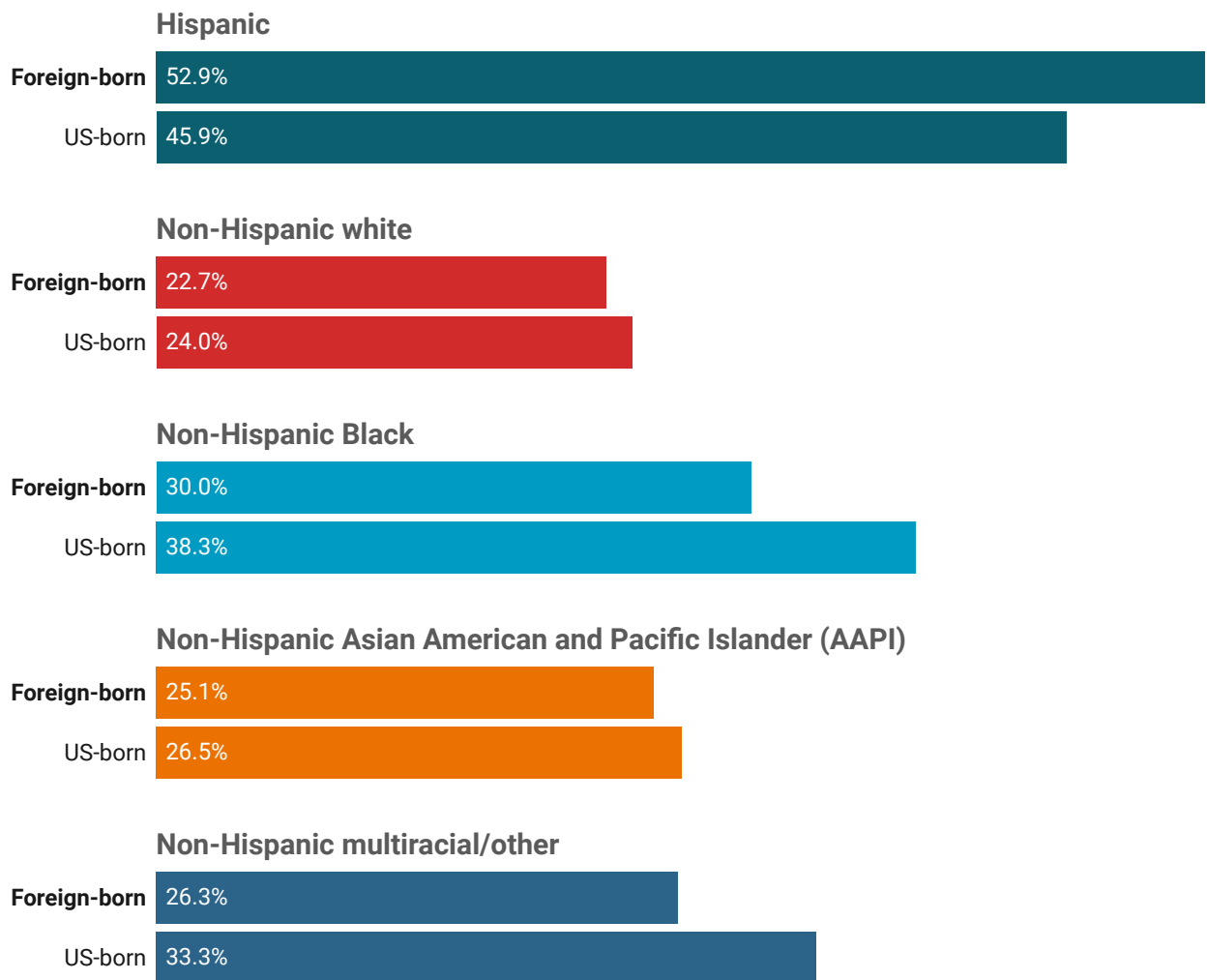


# ... but this is driven by high prevalence of low-wage work among foreign-born Hispanics: More than half of all foreign-born Hispanic workers are paid low wages

The bars show the prevalence of low-wage work across all race/ethnicities, by nativity (US-born or foreign-born). For example, 52.9% of all Hispanic foreign-born workers are paid low wages.



In 2022, the value of the low-wage threshold is \$19.69. The sample includes workers who live and work in California, were employed last week but not self-employed, ages 16+, and with non-zero earnings last week. All racial/ethnic categories are mutually exclusive.
