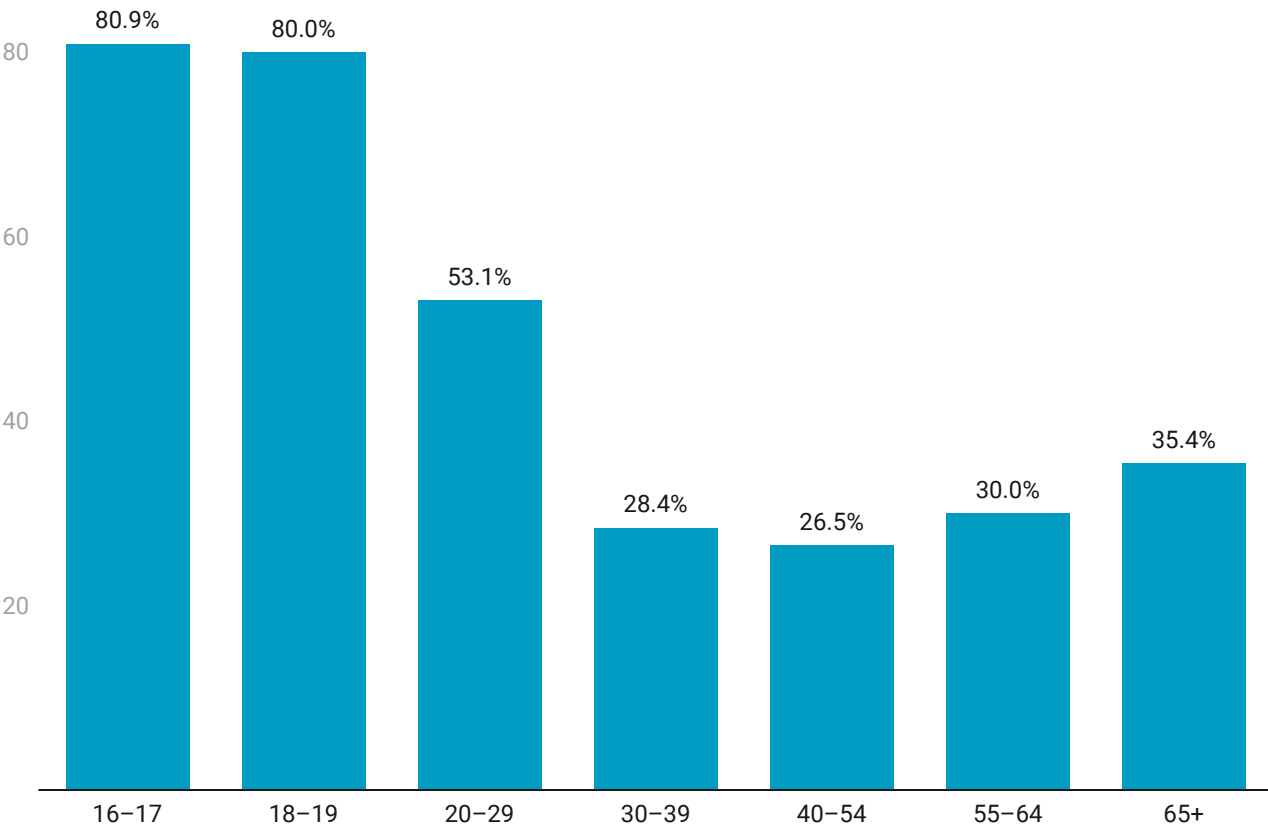


The prevalence of low-wage work generally decreases with age; however, more than 1 in 4 workers over the age of 30 and 1 in 3 workers over the age of 65 are paid low wages

The bars show the prevalence of low-wage work among different age groups. For example, 35.4% of workers aged 65 and older are paid low wages.



In 2022, the value of the low-wage threshold is \$19.69. The sample includes workers who live and work in California, were employed last week but not self-employed, ages 16+, and with non-zero earnings last week.
