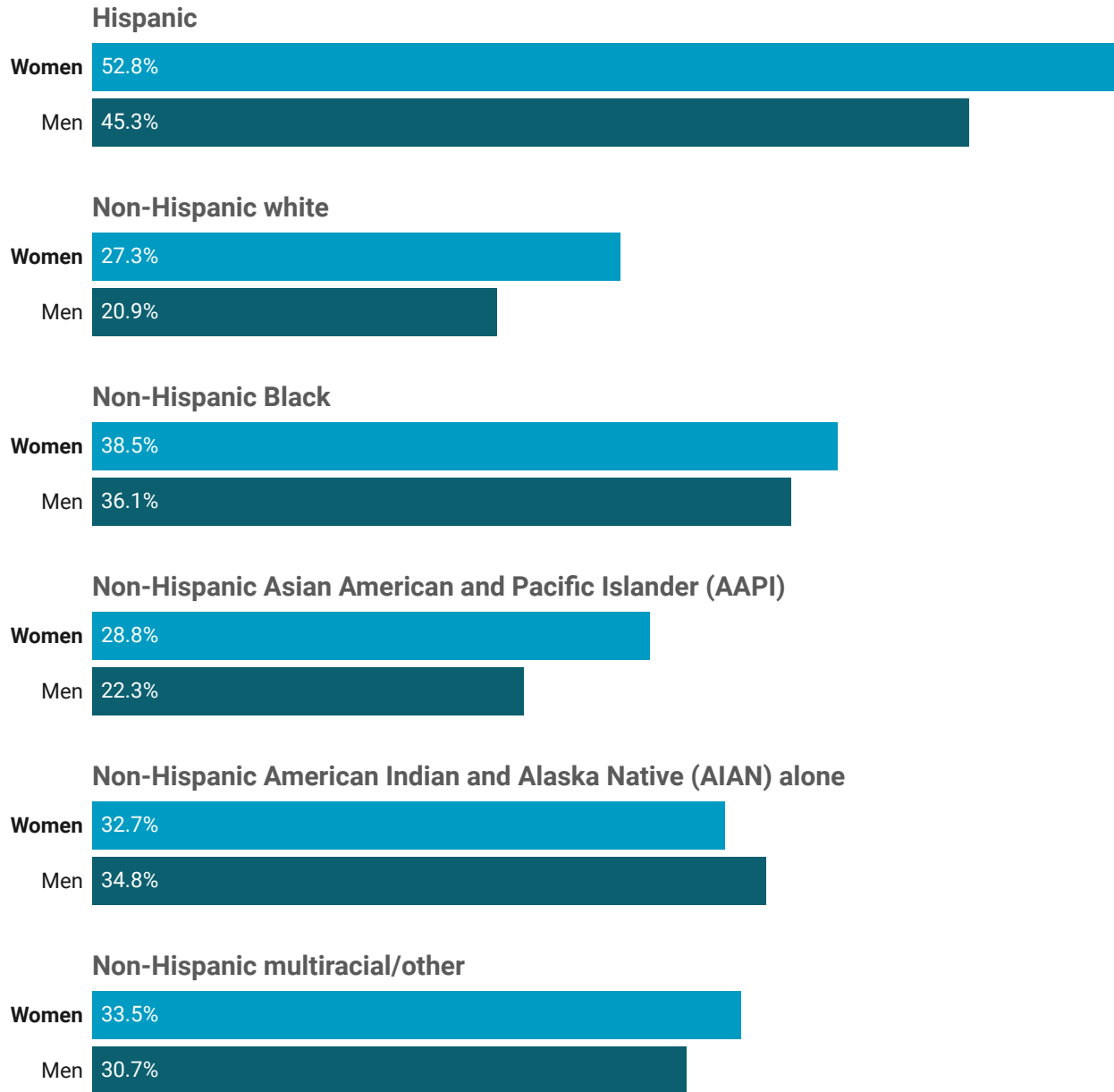


Hispanic women are the most likely to be paid low wages: Over half of all Hispanic women in California were paid less than \$19.69 per hour in 2022

The bars show the prevalence of low-wage work across all race/ethnicities by gender. For example, 52.8% of all Hispanic women are paid low wages.



In 2022, the value of the low-wage threshold is \$19.69. The sample includes workers who live and work in California, were employed last week but not self-employed, ages 16+, and with non-zero earnings last week. All racial/ethnic categories are mutually exclusive.
