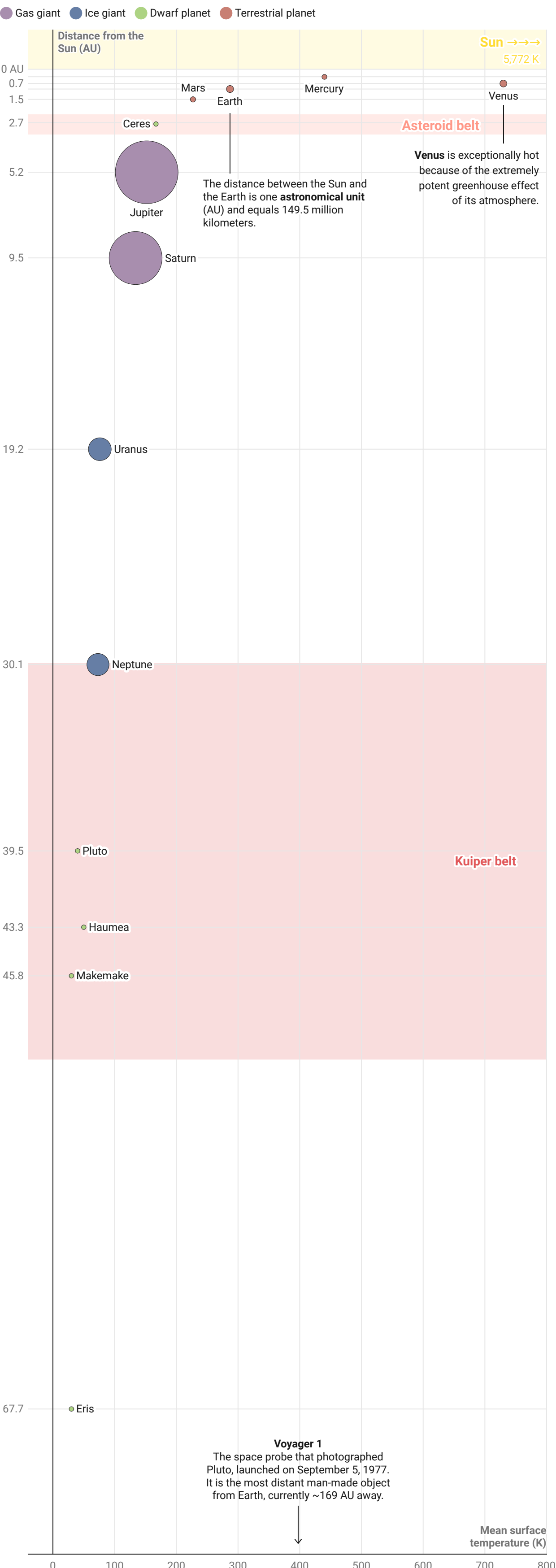


Where are our dwarf planets?

Ceres is the only **dwarf planet** in the inner solar system, specifically between Mars and Jupiter in the asteroid belt. The other four dwarf planets are much further away, further than Neptune, the solar system most distant planet.



The sizes of the planets are not to scale to the distances. They are extrapolated to make them visible.
